Tax Policy in Transition: Diverging Views in a Converging World

Washington, January 23, 2017 – The Tax Council Policy Institute (TCPI) announced today that its 18th Annual Tax Policy & Practice Symposium will be held on February 16-17, 2017, at the Ritz-Carlton Hotel in Washington, DC. The program is titled “Tax Policy in Transition: Diverging Views in a Converging World.” The program manager for the event is EY, a global leader in assurance, tax, transaction and advisory services.
